

## Request for participants at an emergency services disaster exercise in Smethwick on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2010



### We need your help! – Exercise Stable

A simulated emergency exercise will be held on the afternoon of Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2010 to test the emergency services response to a large scale incident.

Up to 40 participants are required to play the part of injured and uninjured survivors of this incident. You will be required from 1pm and no later than 5pm.

Therefore, if you are interested, here's what it entails:

- Register your interest as detailed below.
- Some of you will be given simulated injuries and all of you will be briefed as to how things will work and exactly what your role will be
- You will need to wear old, comfortable clothing suitable to the weather conditions.
- Under 18s will need to be accompanied by a responsible adult, and a parental consent form available upon request will need to be completed.
- You will receive a certification of appreciation for your involvement and an out of pocket reimbursement of £5 per person to cover your costs (paid in cash on the day).
- If you have never done anything like this before, it is an interesting experience.
- An actual disaster could be devastating - our goal is to be as prepared as possible.
